Site Requirements

Power: Ideally 1x 15A Single Phase outlet or a 20A or 32A Three Phase 5pin outlet

Area: Caravan Dimensions are 6.95m (long) x 2.35m (wide) x 2.55m (high) UNHITCHED, however a total working area of 6.8m x 5.5m must be available and on relatively flat/level ground.

Access: All vehicle access gates must be a minimum of 2.5m wide with sufficient turning area before and after as total length when hitched to towing vehicle is 12.5m. Access routes must not be severely corrugated or rutted/washed, and must not have steep inclines/declines. Caravan is BOGIE AXLE (2 axles), meaning that grass scrubbing is HIGHLY LIKELY if access routes involve tight corners. If Access is too wet/boggy, we may cancel the use of our Drawback DJ Caravan at your desired location. Access route must have a minimum height clearance of 2.8m.
